Horses or ponies that are BS/BE/SJI registered or have been placed 1st to 6th in any BS/BE/SJI competition cannot enter class 1 (except as HC).

Dressage only Intro C (2016)

Section A Combined Training Prelim 2 (2016)

Prelim 2 + 50cm show jumping.

Section B Dressage only Prelim 2 (2016)

Class 4

Section A Combined Training Prelim 14 (2006)

Prelim 14 + 65cm show jumping.

Section B Dressage only Prelim 14 (2006)

Class 5

Section A Combined Training Novice 24 (2010)

Novice 24 + 75cm show jumping.

Section B Dressage only Novice 24 (2010)

Class 6

Section A PYO Combined Training Novice 27 (2007) or Elementary 44 (2002)

Novice 27 or Elementary 44 + 85cm or 95cm show jumping (please state choice of test and SJ height with entry)

Section B PYO Dressage only Novice 27 (2007) or Elementary 44 (2002)

Clear Round £5 per round (pay on the gate) – open all day subject to space around Combined Training

Open to all

No horse and rider combination entered in the Combined Training competition may jump the course at any height before attempting it as phase two of the Competition. They may attempt the course as many times as they wish after their phase two round.

Starting at Cross Poles at 9.00am and rising according to timing of the Combined Training Competition.

COMBINED TRAINING SCORING

The score from the dressage phase will be converted to penalties by evaluating the
score as a percentage rounded to 1 decimal place and subtracting this result from
100. The penalties from the show jumping phase will be added to this to give an
individual total penalty. The individual with the lowest number of penalties will win.
The method of scoring for the Show Jumping phase is:

Knock down.....	4 penalties
1 st disobedience	4 penalties
2 nd disobedience	8 penalties
3 rd disobedience	Elimination
1 st fall of rider.....	8 penalties
2 nd fall of rider	Elimination
1 st fall of horse.....	Elimination

In the event of equality of individuals for any place then the highest dressage scores
shall be the deciding factor. If equality still remains the dressage collective scores
shall be the deciding factor

GENERAL CONDITIONS AND RULES OF ENTRY

1. No liability shall fall on the Organisers, Landowners, Judges or Officials in respect of any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused and all competitors are deemed to be liable to indemnify the said persons in respect of any such loss, damage or injury.
2. Every effort will be made to keep to the schedules, but we reserve the right to alter the order and composition of classes or to cancel them.
3. Any competitor may be warned or disqualified for improper or excessive use of whips, spurs etc. or other actions which the Judges or Officials consider warrants such penalty.
4. Correct riding attire must be worn at all times. All riders whether competing or not, must wear the correct headgear with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Skull caps must be worn with a dark silk. Hats must conform to at least one of British PAS 015: 1998 or 2011 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC Marked; VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC Marked
European VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC Marked American ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked SNELL E2001 and SNELL E2016
Australian and New Zealand AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked. Failure to wear approved headgear will incur elimination.
5. All horses being ridden on the showground must be 4 years or older.
6. Stallions must be handled and ridden by people who have attained their 14th birthday on the 1st January in the current year.
7. The ruling of the judges is final. All complaints must be put in writing and handed to the secretary with a deposit of £20 within 15 minutes of the incident, returnable if the objection is upheld.
8. Entries may be refused without reason being given.
9. A refund (less admin fee) will be issued on production of a Medical/Veterinary Certificate or at the Secretary's discretion.
10. Change of horse and/or rider must be notified to the Secretary 15 minutes before the start of the class or the entry will become void.
11. ALL DOGS must be kept on leads (non-extending) at all times.
12. It is the responsibility of competitors to know the rules – our stewards and officials are there to help and advise. Please remember all our helpers are volunteers.
13. Show Jumping – Practice jumps will be flagged (red flag on the right) and must only be jumped in the direction indicated. Anyone breaking this rule may be eliminated.
