RING 1 In Hand Classes - Commencing 9am sharp

Class 1: Youngstock (CTR Q)

Yearlings, two and three year olds. Open to mares, geldings and stallions.

Class 2: In Hand Mountain & Moorland – Small Breeds (CTR Q)

Open to stallions, geldings and mares. Open to Welsh section A and B, Shetlands and Miniature Shetlands, Exmoors and Dartmoors.

Class 3: Part Bred In Hand

Horses and ponies of any size and age who are a part bred of any breeding.

Class 4: Best Condition In Hand (CTR Q)

Horses and ponies of all heights and ages. Plaited or unplaited

RING 2 In Hand Classes - Commencing 9am sharp

Class 5: In Hand Veterans (CTR Q)

To include horses and ponies aged 15 years and over. Open to stallions, mares and geldings.

Class 6: In Hand Mountain & Moorland – Large Breeds (CTR Q)

Open to stallions, geldings and mares. Welsh Section C and D, Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara and New Forest.

Class 7: In Hand Coloured/Odd Coloured (CTR Q)

For skewbald, piebald, palomino, dun, appaloosa, roan, spotted, paint or cream coloureds. All heights. Open to stallions, mares and geldings.

Class 8: In Hand Cob

Open to stallions, geldings and mares. Native, traditional or show cob.

In Hand Championship once all in hand classes have finished. Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 1-8. Kindly sponsored by Gillian and Nick Hickford.



RIDDEN CLASSES *Not before 11am*

Class 9: Novice Ridden/Rider (CTR Q)

A walk and trot showing class for novices. No lead reins allowed. Combinations must meet one of the required criteria:

*Novice horses and ponies in their first season who have never won a showing class before the date of show **OR** novice riders who have never won a showing class before the date of show.*

Class 10: Childs pony

Ponies 148cms and under. May be plaited or non-plaited. Rider to be under 16 years old on 1st January 2018. Mares or Geldings 4 years and over. To be judged on the suitability of the pony to its rider. May be led. Conformation will not be taken into account.

Class 11: Ridden Pony Club/Riding Club Pony (CTR Q)

For ponies not exceeding 153cm that make good all rounders. Open to mares or geldings 4 years and over. Snaffle bridles only. May be asked to jump a small jump.

Class 12: Ridden Mountain & Moorland (CTR Q)

Will be split large/small breeds if there are sufficient entries. Please state on entry form whether large or small. Lead reins are not permitted. Ponies 4 years and over

Class 13: Ridden Part Bred (CTR Q)

Horses and ponies of any size and age who are a part bred of any breeding. Lead reins are not permitted.

Class 14: Ridden Veteran (CTR Q)

For horses and ponies aged 15 years +. Open to stallions, mares and geldings. Lead reins are not permitted.

Class 15: Ridden Show Horse

For horses exc 148cm. To be turned out to type. Riding Horse, Show Hack or Show Hunter. Open to stallions, mares and geldings, 4 years and over.

Class 16: Ridden Coloured/Odd Coloured (CTR Q)

For skewbald, piebald, palomino, dun, appaloosa, roan, spotted, paint or cream coloureds. All heights. Open to stallions, mares and geldings, 4 years and over. Lead reins are not permitted.

Class 17: Ridden Cob (CTR Q)

Open to Stallion, mares and gelding over 148cm and 4 years and over. To be turned out to type (inc Show Cobs (trimmed and hogged), Maxi Cobs (trimmed and hogged), Native Cobs and Traditional Cobs.

Ridden Championship once all ridden classes have finished. Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 9-17. Kindly sponsored by ME Pilates for Equestrians.

In Hand classes - The school will be split into two rings and classes 1 to 4 and 5 to 8 will be run concurrently.

Ridden classes - The whole school will be used. No ponies/horses on lead reins are permitted in ridden classes other than class 10.

Rosettes: 1st – 6th place in all classes

Please leave the box park clean and tidy. Competitors must not use the fields and tracks at BCA to warm up or to hack.



Please note: Access to the college grounds is from 8am onwards. Please do not arrive before this time.

This show is a qualifier for the Chiltern and Thames Rider Summer Championships 2018 to be held at Bury Farm Equestrian Centre on 1st September 2018

Rules for CTRider Qualifiers 2018

- Horses and Ponies who have qualified for or competed at HOYS in the years 2015, 2016 or 2017/2018 are not eligible for the C&T Rider Showing Championships.
- This Championship is aimed at keen and competitive amateurs – PRODUCERS ARE EXCLUDED.
- Stallions must be handled and ridden by people who have attained their 14th birthday on 1st January 2018. THEY MUST WEAR STALLON BADGES.
- Passports must be available for inspection if asked for by a judge or official of the show.
- Qualification can pass down the line as far as 5th place.
- All riders who want to be eligible to qualify must be CT Rider Members. New memberships for the 2017/2018 season are now on sale and can be purchased on line by visiting www.chilternrider.co.uk or by ringing our offices on 01234 211245.
- REMEMBER – Show secretaries are not required to send their results to CT Rider anymore. **All members with a qualification card which they must get signed in the ring by the judge.**
- Many classes at the CTR Championships will be qualifiers for Equifest 2018 and Ponies (UK). The Veteran classes are qualifiers for The Veteran Horse Society Championships. The Ridden Cob classes are qualifiers for the Traditional Gypsy Cob Society Championships.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE: Please do not enter qualifying classes if your horse or pony is not eligible. You will get spotted. In 2006, 2007 and 2017 we had to disqualify a horse and pony which is embarrassing and causes a lot of problems.

GENERAL CONDITIONS AND RULES OF ENTRY

1. No liability shall fall on the Organisers, Landowners, Judges or Officials in respect of any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused and all competitors are deemed to be liable to indemnify the said persons in respect of any such loss, damage or injury.
2. Every effort will be made to keep to the schedules, but we reserve the right to alter the order and composition of classes or to cancel them.
3. Any competitor may be warned or disqualified for improper or excessive use of whips, spurs etc. or other actions which the Judges or Officials consider warrants such penalty.
4. Correct riding attire must be worn at all times. All riders whether competing or not, must wear the correct headgear with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Skull caps must be worn with a dark silk. Hats must conform to at least one of PAS 015:1998 or 2011, VG1 01.040 (2014-12) and must also be kitemarked or SEI. All SEI ASTM F1163:2004, SNELL E2001. All SAI AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards. Failure to wear approved headgear will incur elimination.
5. All horses being ridden on the showground must be 4 years or older.
6. Stallions must be handled and ridden by people who have attained their 14th birthday on the 1st January in the current year.
7. The ruling of the judges is final. All complaints must be put in writing and handed to the secretary with a deposit of £20 within 15 minutes of the incident, returnable if the objection is upheld.
8. Entries may be refused without reason being given.
9. A refund (less admin fee) will be issued on production of a Medical/Veterinary Certificate or at the Secretary's discretion.
10. Change of horse and/or rider must be notified to the Secretary 15 minutes before the start of the class or the entry will become void.
11. ALL DOGS must be kept on leads (non-extending) at all times.
12. It is the responsibility of competitors to know the rules – our stewards and officials are there to help and advise. Please remember all our helpers are volunteers.
13. Show Jumping – Practice jumps will be flagged (red flag on the right) and must only be jumped in the direction indicated. Anyone breaking this rule may be eliminated.
